

The EMD Serono Fertility Instant Savings program is a fertility medication discount program aimed at increasing access to all EMD Serono fertility medications. This new pricing program provides patients that have been prescribed an EMD Serono fertility medication with reduced out-of-pocket prices.

PATIENT FAQs

What is TrumpRx?

TrumpRx is a website operated by the U.S. Federal Government aimed at providing medication price transparency. The website will present the out-of-pocket price for all participating medications. Patients will be redirected to the manufacturers' website to access the displayed pricing.

How can patients access their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications at these new discounted prices?

Although medication prices will be displayed on TrumpRx.gov, the only place a patient can gain access to the discounted pricing is through EMD Serono's program website that will launch in January 2026. Patients will fill out a short online form and instantly receive the information they need to redeem the medication savings for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications at participating pharmacies. Patients can also go directly to the new EMD Serono program website once it launches.

What patients are eligible for this discount?

This new discount is for patients paying out-of-pocket (i.e. not using insurance) for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications. This can mean:

- Patients who are paying out-of-pocket for the entirety of their fertility treatment services and medications
- Patients who are choosing to use their insurance to pay for fertility treatments, but paying out-of-pocket for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications

Is the U.S. Government collecting patient health data?

No. The program is being administered by EMD Serono in compliance with all privacy laws. No patient health data is being shared with the U.S. Government. Patients do not have to go through TrumpRx.gov to access the discounted medication.

When does the new pricing go into effect?

We are planning for the new program to go live in January 2026. Until the program launches, patients will continue to be able to access all prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications through the company's existing pharmacy network and savings programs for eligible patients.

If a patient has already been approved for a Compassionate Care discount, will the new discount be automatically applied?

At this time, we do not have details on how the new pricing program will affect existing discounts, including the Compassionate Care discount. More information will be available in the coming weeks. Please continue to check FertilitySavings.com for the latest updates and information.

Will the new pricing provide more savings than a patient's Compassionate Care discount?

It's possible that some Compassionate Care patients will see increased discounts under the new program. Individual eligibility requirements will determine the amount of savings for each patient. Can patients still access their fertility medications through their existing pharmacy?

Patients can continue to access all their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications through the company's existing pharmacy network. This new program will go live in January 2026. If a patient does not live in the U.S., but is getting fertility treatments here, will they be eligible for the new program?

This new program will be available to all patients paying out-of-pocket for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications who reside in the U.S. and are 18 years of age or older.

What EMD Serono medications qualify for a discount through TrumpRx?

EMD Serono will offer these discounts on our complete portfolio of IVF therapies to all patients paying out-of-pocket (self-pay) for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications who reside in the U.S. and are 18 years of age or older at significantly reduced prices.

Will patients be able to order these medications on the TrumpRx platform as soon as the program starts in January?

The new medication pricing will go into effect in January 2026. Patients will not order or pay for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications on TrumpRx.gov directly. They will be redirected to an EMD Serono website for their individual discount code which they can use at a participating pharmacy to access the discounted pricing. This new program is expected to be available in January 2026. The exact date is not yet available. Please continue to check FertilitySavings.com for the latest updates and information.

What is the list price and what will the discounted price be for each medication?

Exact pricing has not been published as of this time, but our fertility medications will be available at significantly lower prices for all patients paying out-of-pocket for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications. When this is available, we will communicate.

If a patient is starting a cycle this year, can they access the new program pricing now?

The new program will go live in January 2026. Until the program launches, our fertility medications will continue to be available through our existing pharmacy network and savings programs for eligible patients. Patients should always talk to their doctor about what's best for them.

Will patients be able to access the new program regardless of which fertility process they are using?

E.g. IVF (in vitro fertilization), IUI (intrauterine insemination), egg preservation, or surrogacy or donation?

Yes. This new program will be available to all patients who choose to pay out-of-pocket for their prescribed EMD Serono fertility medications, without using insurance benefits to cover their medication costs.
